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| Aqua (water) | Water from The Yorkshire Moors | Holds components in solution (solvent) |
| Allergy Free Fragrance | Blended composition of partly essential oils & synthetic ingredients | Subtle & Fresh Scents |
| Cocamidopropyl Betaine | Coconut based amphoteric surfactant | Mild cleaning & foaming agent |
| Decyl Glucoside | Non-Ionic Surfactant derived from coconut | Helps remove dirt & grime |
| Hydroxyethyl Cellulose | Thickening Agent, derived from cellulose | Helps thicken products |
| Lactic Acid | Organic acid fermented from bacteria & glucose | A good descaler & soap scum remover |
| PEG 7 Glyceryl Cocoate | Conditioning Agent, derived from coconut oil fatty acids | Helps condition the hair & skin, giving shine & softness |
| Potassium Sorbate | Salt from sorbic acid, which is a natural organic compound usually found in food | Prevents growth of bacteria |
| Sodium Benzoate | Salt of benzoic acid, which is a natural organic compound usually found in food | Prevents growth of bacteria |
| Sorbitol | Derived from sugar alcohols that are naturally found in fruits and plants | Helps moisturise skin |
